NOTICE TO RESPONDENTS
IN ALL DISSOLUTIONS AND MOTIONS TO MODIFY
DISSOLUTIONS
RE: PARENTAL EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS

By Court Order this Notice accompanies all petitions for dissolution decrees filed in the City of St. Louis Circuit Court and served on respondents. The directions herein apply to all petitioners and respondents in such cases where there are unemancipated children of the marriage.

The requirements of City of St. Louis local Court Rule 68.10 state both spouses to a dissolution (divorce) or motion to modify dissolution decree must attend an educational session for the benefit of the children of the marriage. When there are unemancipated children of the marriage at the time of the dissolution or filing of a motion to modify a dissolution decree, the Court will require both parties to separately attend an educational session to educate parents as to the possible detrimental effects of divorce proceedings on children and how to avoid those negative effects.

Educational sessions are offered free of charge two times a week by Kids in the middle, Inc. The sessions are two hours long and certificates of completion will be given at the end of the session to you and furnished the Court. You must call Kids in the Middle at (314) 909-9922 to arrange to attend a session. Your call is necessary to ensure you do not attend when your spouse does and because of limited class size.

If you are represented by an attorney you should discuss the requirements of this Notice with that attorney. If you are not represented and the conditions of this notice apply, you should contact Kids in the Middle to attend an educational session prior to your dissolution or motion to modify being granted.
